The 2015 Crus Bourgeois du Médoc Cup

This year, the Crus Bourgeois du Médoc will be awarding the Crus Bourgeois du Médoc Cup on June 14th at Château du Taillan.

As in the previous five years, the event is organised by Jacques Dupont, journalist at Le Point magazine, the event's partner.

The competition will be held at Château du Taillan on Sunday June 14th. A panel of distinguished figures from the wine world (sommeliers, oenologists, journalists...) will have the task of judging the Crus Bourgeois du Médoc that make up the 2012 Official Selection.

175 Crus Bourgeois du Médoc from the 2012 Official Selection will be competing, from which the specially selected jury will identify their top twelve wines.

A super jury will then carry out another blind tasting of the top twelve to determine an overall winner.

The awarding of the Cup and trophies to the 12 winners will be held the next day at the Vinexpo Trade Show on Monday June 15th at 3.30 pm in Hall 2, Tasting Lab 4, in the presence of Jacques Dupont and Frédéric de Luze, President of the Alliance of the Crus Bourgeois du Médoc. The ceremony will be followed by a tasting of the 12 winning wines (2012 vintage).

Reminder: The Crus Bourgeois du Médoc Cup took place every year between 1985 and 1999 and was a popular event with professionals and journalists in the wine sector. This event was updated and reintroduced in 2011 in partnership with the magazine Le Point.
